A KEY LOGISTIC HUB ON YOUR DOORSTEP:

Thanks to a perfect geographical location, Slovakia is one of the key logistics hubs in Europe, offering quick access to neighbouring countries by road, river, rail, air, and also pipeline. By car, it takes only 45 mins to get to Vienna, Austria, 2.5 hours to Budapest, Hungary, and 3.5 hours to get to Prague, Czech Republic.

EASY CONNECTIONS TO THE UK:

The CEE is one of the easiest destinations to fly to, in which flight time to the UK is only 2-3 hours. There are vast numbers of direct flights to several of the UK major cities.

BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES:

Slovakia is a hub for ICT and shared service centers. Such companies as IBM, T-systems, AT&T, HP, Dell and Accenture are emloying more than thousands of employees within their SSC in Slovakia. In general, more than 30 000 people are employed by Slovak shared service centers and business process outsourcing centers.

AUTOMOTIVE:

The automotive industry has a strong tradition in Slovakia and became the most important sector and driving force of the Slovak economy. Over the past 20 years it has been an important source of foreign direct investment. In 2016, the number of cars produced exceeded the magic limit of 1 million units. For 2017, the production of new vehicles is estimated at over 1 million units. More than 80 000 people are employed directly by the 3 car producers - VW, PSA, Kia & Tier 1 suppliers. The number will continue to grow also thanks to new Jaguar Land Rover plant which starts with production in 2018.





THE WORKFORCE - OPTIMISE YOUR COSTS AND INCREASE YOUR PRODUCTIVITY:

Slovakia excels in adaptability of labour force to different culture management styles. Strong English language competency gives a big add on for most British companies. Slovakia reaches one of the highest shares of workforce with secondary and higher education among all the European countries.

The cost of labour force is another important indicator. Slovakia has lower overhead costs than Western Europe, which enables companies to optimise production costs.

On the plus side, Slovakia is the CEE leader in labour productivity and according to OECD belongs to one of TOP 10 hardworking countries along with the United States or Japan.
